1 AN ACT Relating to the repair and maintenance of backflow
2 prevention assemblies; and amending RCW 18.106.010 and 18.106.040.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 18.106.010 and 1997 c 326 s 2 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 Unless a different meaning is plainly required by the context, the
7 following words and phrases as hereinafter used in this chapter shall
8 have the following meaning:

9 (1) "Advisory board" means the state advisory board of plumbers;

10 (2) "Department" means the department of labor and industries;

11 (3) "Director" means the director of department of labor and
12 industries;

13 (4) "Journeyman plumber" means any person who has been issued a
14 certificate of competency by the department of labor and industries as
15 provided in this chapter;

16 (5) "Medical gas piping" means oxygen, nitrous oxide, high pressure
17 nitrogen, medical compressed air, and medical vacuum systems;

18 (6) "Medical gas piping installer" means a journeyman plumber who
19 has been issued a medical gas piping installer endorsement;

1 (7) "Plumbing" means that craft involved in installing, altering,
2 repairing and renovating potable water systems, liquid waste systems,
3 and medical gas piping systems within a building. Installation in a
4 water system of water softening or water treatment equipment is not
5 within the meaning of plumbing as used in this chapter;

6 (8) "Specialty plumber" means anyone who has been issued a
7 specialty certificate of competency limited to:

8 (a) Installation, maintenance, and repair of the plumbing of
9 single-family dwellings, duplexes, and apartment buildings that do not
10 exceed three stories; or

11 (b) In-line maintenance of backflow prevention assemblies within
12 buildings. For the purposes of this subsection, "maintenance" includes
13 cleaning and replacing parts of an assembly, but does not include
14 installing, altering, or repairing of backflow prevention assemblies.

15 **Sec. 2.** RCW 18.106.040 and 1977 ex.s. c 149 s 4 are each amended
16 to read as follows:

17 (1) Upon receipt of the application and evidence set forth in RCW
18 18.106.030, the director shall review the same and make a determination
19 as to whether the applicant is eligible to take an examination for the
20 certificate of competency. To be eligible to take the examination:

21 (a) Each applicant for a journeyman plumber's certificate of
22 competency shall furnish written evidence that he or she has ~~((either))~~
23 completed a course of study in the plumbing trade in the armed services
24 of the United States or at a school accredited by the coordinating
25 council on occupational education~~((+))~~, or ~~((that he))~~ has had four or
26 more years of experience under the direct supervision of a licensed
27 journeyman plumber.

28 (b) Each applicant for a specialty plumber's certificate of
29 competency shall furnish written evidence that he or she has ~~((either))~~
30 completed a course of study in the plumbing trade in the armed services
31 of the United States or at a school ~~((accredited by the commission for~~
32 ~~vocational education or its designee))~~ licensed by the work force
33 training and education coordinating board under chapter 28C.10 RCW, or
34 that he or she has had at least three years practical experience in
35 ~~((his))~~ the specialty.

36 (c) Each applicant for a backflow prevention assembly specialty
37 plumber's certificate of competency shall furnish written evidence that

1 he or she is certified as a backflow assembly tester by the department
2 of health, and is registered as a contractor by the department.

3 (2) No other requirement for eligibility may be imposed.

4 (3) The director shall establish reasonable rules and regulations
5 for the examinations to be given applicants for certificates of
6 competency. In establishing said rules, regulations, and criteria, the
7 director shall consult with the state advisory board of plumbers as
8 established in RCW 18.106.110.

9 (4) Upon determination that the applicant is eligible to take the
10 examination, the director shall so notify ((him)) the applicant,
11 indicating the time and place for taking the same.

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
