- AN ACT Relating to membership of the emergency management council;
- 2 and amending RCW 38.52.040.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 38.52.040 and 1995 c 269 s 1202 are each amended to 5 read as follows:
- 6 (1)(a) There is hereby created the emergency management council
- 7 (hereinafter called the council), to consist of ((not more than
- 8 seventeen)) members who shall be appointed by the governor. The
- 9 membership of the council shall include, but not be limited to,
- 10 representatives of city and county governments, sheriffs and police
- 11 chiefs, the Washington state patrol, the military department, the
- 12 department of ecology, state and local fire chiefs, <u>local public health</u>
- 13 agencies, seismic safety experts, state and local emergency management
- 14 directors, search and rescue volunteers, medical professions who have
- 15 expertise in emergency medical care, building officials, ((and))
- 16 private industry, and other members the governor deems necessary. The
- 17 representatives of private industry shall include persons knowledgeable
- 18 in emergency and hazardous materials management.

- (b) In addition to the members specified in (a) of this subsection, the council shall include four legislative members appointed by the governor to serve as nonvoting advisory members of the council. The legislative members shall be appointed as follows:
- 5 <u>(i) Two members shall be appointed from the house of</u>
  6 representatives, one from each of the two largest caucuses in the house
  7 of representatives, based on the recommendations of the speaker and the
  8 minority leader of the house of representatives; and
- 9 <u>(ii) Two members shall be appointed from the senate, one from each</u>
  10 <u>of the two largest caucuses in the senate, based on the recommendations</u>
  11 of the senate majority leader and minority leader.
- (2) The council members shall elect a chairman from within the 12 council membership. The members of the council shall serve without 13 compensation, but legislative members may be reimbursed in accordance 14 15 with RCW 44.04.120 for travel expenses incurred in the performance of 16 their duties, and nonlegislative members may be reimbursed for their 17 travel expenses incurred in the performance of their duties in accordance with RCW 43.03.050 and 43.03.060 ((as now existing or 18 19 hereafter amended)).
  - $((\frac{1}{2}))$  (3) The emergency management council shall advise the governor and the director on all matters pertaining to state and local emergency management. The council may appoint such ad hoc committees, subcommittees, and working groups as are required to develop specific recommendations for the improvement of emergency management practices, standards, policies, or procedures. The council shall ensure that the governor receives an annual assessment of statewide emergency preparedness including, but not limited to, specific progress on hazard mitigation and reduction efforts, implementation of seismic safety improvements, reduction of flood hazards, and coordination of hazardous materials planning and response activities.
- 31 (4) The council or a subcommittee thereof shall periodically convene in special session and serve during those sessions as the state 32 emergency response commission required by P.L. 99-499, the emergency 33 34 planning and community right-to-know act. When sitting in session as 35 the state emergency response commission, the council shall confine its deliberations to those items specified in federal statutes and state 36 37 administrative rules governing the coordination of hazardous materials policy. The council shall review administrative rules governing state 38
