- 1 AN ACT Relating to creating a law enforcement memorial; amending
- 2 RCW 46.16.313; and adding a new section to chapter 46.16 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 46.16 RCW
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 The law enforcement memorial account is created in the custody of
- 7 the state treasurer. All receipts from the sale of special license
- 8 plates for the law enforcement memorial, less the administration and
- 9 collection costs incurred by the department of licensing under RCW
- 10 46.16.313 (6) and (7), must be deposited into the account.
- 11 Expenditures from the account may be used only for building and
- 12 maintaining a law enforcement memorial on the capitol campus. Only the
- 13 director of general administration or the director's designee may
- 14 authorize expenditures from the account. The account is subject to
- 15 allotment procedures under chapter 43.88 RCW, but an appropriation is
- 16 not required for expenditures.
- 17 **Sec. 2.** RCW 46.16.313 and 1997 c 291 s 8 are each amended to read
- 18 as follows:

p. 1 HB 2409

(1) The department may establish a fee for each type of special 1 license plates issued under RCW 46.16.301(1) (a), (b), or (c), as 2 3 existing before amendment by section 5, chapter 291, Laws of 1997, in 4 an amount calculated to offset the cost of production of the special license plates and the administration of this program. Until December 5 31, 1997, the fee shall not exceed thirty-five dollars, but effective 6 7 with vehicle registrations due or to become due on January 1, 1998, the 8 department may adjust the fee to no more than forty dollars. This fee 9 is in addition to all other fees required to register and license the vehicle for which the plates have been requested. All such additional 10 special license plate fees collected by the department shall be 11 deposited in the state treasury and credited to the motor vehicle fund. 12

- (2) Until December 31, 1997, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon application, registration, and renewal registration of a motor vehicle, the holder of a collegiate license plate shall pay a fee of thirty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds, minus the cost of plate production, shall be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. The state treasurer shall credit the funds to the appropriate collegiate license plate fund as provided in RCW 28B.10.890.
- 24 (3) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due on 25 January 1, 1998, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid 26 upon application and registration of a motor vehicle, the holder of a collegiate license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty dollars. 27 The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve dollars of 28 29 each fee collected under this subsection for administration and 30 collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall be 31 remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. The state treasurer shall credit the 32 funds to the appropriate collegiate license plate fund as provided in 33 34 RCW 28B.10.890.
- 35 (4) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on January 36 1, 1999, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon 37 renewal of a motor vehicle registration, the holder of a collegiate 38 license plate shall pay a fee of thirty dollars. The department shall 39 deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee collected under

this subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. The state treasurer shall credit the funds to the appropriate collegiate license plate fund as provided in RCW 28B.10.890.

- 6 (5) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon application and registration of a motor vehicle, the holder of a 7 8 special baseball stadium license plate shall pay an initial fee of 9 forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for 10 administration and collection expenses incurred by it. 11 The remaining proceeds, minus the cost of plate production, shall be distributed to 12 13 a county for the purpose of paying the principal and interest payments on bonds issued by the county to construct a baseball stadium, as 14 15 defined in RCW 82.14.0485, including reasonably preconstruction costs, while the taxes are being collected under RCW 16 17 82.14.360. After this date, the state treasurer shall credit the funds to the state general fund. 18
- 19 (6) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on January 20 1, 1999, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon renewal of a motor vehicle registration, the holder of a special 21 baseball stadium license plate shall pay a fee of thirty dollars. 22 23 department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee 24 collected under this subsection for administration and collection 25 expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall be distributed 26 to a county for the purpose of paying the principal and interest 27 payments on bonds issued by the county to construct a baseball stadium, defined 82.14.0485, including reasonably necessary 28 in RCW preconstruction costs, while the taxes are being collected under RCW 29 82.14.360. After this date, the state treasurer shall credit the funds 30 to the state general fund. 31
- (7) If nine hundred applications are received by November 1, 2002, 32 then effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due on 33 34 January 1, 2003, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid 35 upon application and registration of a motor vehicle, the holder of a special law enforcement memorial license plate shall pay an initial fee 36 of thirty-seven dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to 37 38 exceed twelve dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for 39 administration and collection of expenses incurred by it.

remaining proceeds shall be deposited in the law enforcement memorial account created under section 1 of this act.

(8) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on January 1, 2004, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon renewal of a motor vehicle registration, the holder of a special law enforcement memorial license plate shall pay a fee of twenty-seven dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall be deposited in the law enforcement memorial account created under section 1 of this act.
