1 AN ACT Relating to advisory board of plumbers; and amending RCW
2 18.106.110.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 18.106.110 and 1997 c 307 s 1 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 (1) There is created a state advisory board of plumbers, to be
7 composed of five members appointed by the governor. Two members shall
8 be journeyman plumbers, two members shall be persons conducting a
9 plumbing business, and one member from the general public who is
10 familiar with the business and trade of plumbing.

11 (2) The term of one journeyman plumber expires July 1, 1995; the
12 term of the second journeyman plumber expires July 1, 2000; the term of
13 one person conducting a plumbing business expires July 1, 1996; the
14 term of the second person conducting a plumbing business expires July
15 1, 2000; and the term of the public member expires July 1, 1997.
16 Thereafter, upon the expiration of said terms, the governor shall
17 appoint a new member to serve for a period of three years. However, to
18 ensure that the board can continue to act, a member whose term expires
19 shall continue to serve until his or her replacement is appointed. In

1 the case of any vacancy on the board for any reason, the governor shall
2 appoint a new member to serve out the term of the person whose position
3 has become vacant.

4 (3) The advisory board shall carry out all the functions and duties
5 enumerated in this chapter, as well as generally advise the department
6 on all matters relative to this chapter including proposed legislation.

7 (4) Each member of the advisory board shall receive travel expenses
8 in accordance with the provisions of RCW 43.03.050 and 43.03.060 as now
9 existing or hereafter amended for each day in which such member is
10 actually engaged in attendance upon the meetings of the advisory board.
