copying of the records of a water conservancy board must be filed with 1 the department and must specify the records of the board's proceedings 2 and determinations being requested. The department must identify and 3 4 provide to the requestor a copy of each of the records held in the possession of the department and must then forward the request for 5 public inspection and copying for the remaining such records to the 6 conservancy board. The date of the request regarding these remaining 7 8 records is the date the request is received by the board.
