- 1 AN ACT Relating to implementing the results of the 1995-2000
- 2 actuarial experience study; adding a new section to chapter 41.45 RCW;
- 3 repealing RCW 41.45.053; providing an effective date; and declaring an
- 4 emergency.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 41.45 RCW 7 to read as follows:
- 8 The basic employer and state contribution rates and plan 2 member
- 9 contribution rates are changed to reflect the 2000 actuarial valuation,
- 10 incorporating the 1995-2000 actuarial experience study conducted by the
- 11 office of the state actuary. The results of the 2000 actuarial
- 12 valuation shall be adjusted to reflect an April 1, 2002, implementation
- 13 date.
- 14 (1) Beginning April 1, 2002, the following employer contribution
- 15 rates shall be charged:
- 16 (a) 1.10 percent for the public employees' retirement system; and
- 17 (b) 2.64 percent for the law enforcement officers' and fire
- 18 fighters' retirement system plan 2.

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- 1 (2) Beginning April 1, 2002, the basic state contribution rate for
- 2 the law enforcement officers' and fire fighters' retirement system plan
- 3 2 shall be 1.75 percent.
- 4 (3) Beginning April 1, 2002, the following employer contribution 5 rates shall be charged:
- 6 (a) 0.96 percent for the school employees' retirement system; and
- 7 (b) 1.05 percent for the teachers' retirement system.
- 8 (4) Beginning April 1, 2002, the following member contribution
- 9 rates shall be charged:
- 10 (a) 0.65 percent for the public employees' retirement system plan
- 11 2; and
- 12 (b) 4.39 percent for the law enforcement officers' and fire
- 13 fighters' retirement system plan 2.
- 14 (5) Beginning April 1, 2002, the following member contribution
- 15 rates shall be charged:
- 16 (a) 0.35 percent for the school employees' retirement system plan
- 17 2; and
- 18 (b) 0.15 percent for the teachers' retirement system plan 2.
- 19 (6) The contribution rates in this section shall be collected
- 20 through June 30, 2003.
- 21 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** RCW 41.45.053 (Contribution rates--Collected
- 22 through June 30, 2003) and 2001 2nd sp.s. c 11 s 9 are each repealed.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. This act is necessary for the immediate
- 24 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
- 25 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect
- 26 April 1, 2002.

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
