- 1 AN ACT Relating to ensuring truth in lobbying; adding new sections
- 2 to chapter 42.17 RCW; creating a new section; prescribing penalties;
- 3 and declaring an emergency.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** This act may be known and cited as "the
- 6 truth in lobbying act."
- 7 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. The legislature finds that the wrongful use
- 8 by a person or organization of personal information belonging to
- 9 another person or organization for the purposes of influencing the
- 10 policies or conduct of government is harmful to the integrity of the
- 11 person or organization whose personal identity is misappropriated, the
- 12 legislative process, sound public policy, and the democratic
- 13 underpinnings of representative government.
- 14 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** Every person or organization who uses the
- 15 name of another person or organization for the purpose of influencing
- 16 or affecting the policy or conduct, or any proposed policy or conduct,
- 17 of any branch or level of government, or as supporting or opposing any

- 1 policy or conduct, or any proposed policy or conduct, of any branch or
- 2 level of government, without the prior knowledge and consent of the
- 3 other person or organization, is guilty of a misdemeanor.
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** A person or organization has a private cause
- 5 of action against any person or organization that violates section 2 of
- 6 this act. A plaintiff bringing an action under this act may sue to
- 7 recover economic damages and to enjoin any subsequent or ongoing
- 8 violations of section 2 of this act. If the plaintiff prevails, in
- 9 addition to damages proven, the plaintiff shall be awarded costs,
- 10 reasonable attorneys' fees, and statutory damages of five hundred
- 11 dollars per violation as established by a preponderance of the
- 12 evidence.
- 13 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 5.** If, upon all the evidence, the court finds
- 14 that the respondent has not committed a violation of section 2 of this
- 15 act, the court shall dismiss the complaint and may include an award of
- 16 costs and reasonable attorneys' fees in favor of the respondent if the
- 17 court concludes the complaint was groundless.
- 18 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 6.** Sections 2 through 5 of this act are each
- 19 added to chapter 42.17 RCW.
- 20 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 7.** If any provision of this act or its
- 21 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the
- 22 remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other
- 23 persons or circumstances is not affected.
- 24 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 8.** This act is necessary for the immediate
- 25 preservation of the public peace, health, morals, or safety, or support
- 26 of the state government and its existing public institutions, and takes
- 27 effect immediately.
