- 5 (1) The House of Representatives shall transmit to the Senate all 6 Senate bills, Senate joint resolutions, Senate concurrent resolutions, 7 and Senate joint memorials in its possession that have not been passed 8 by the House of Representatives, and upon receipt by the Senate of such 9 measures they shall be assigned to the Senate Rules Committee for third 10 reading; and
 - (2) The Senate shall transmit to the House of Representatives all House bills, House joint resolutions, House concurrent resolutions, and House joint memorials in its possession that have not been passed by the Senate, and upon receipt by the House of Representatives of such measures they shall be assigned to the House Rules Committee for third reading; and
 - BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Co-Chief Clerks of the House of Representatives and the Secretary of the Senate shall retain in their possession and in the status that exists upon the adjournment SINE DIE of the 2001 3rd special session of the Fifty-seventh Legislature all legislative measures including all bills, joint resolutions, concurrent

1 resolutions, and joint memorials that may at that time be in their 2 respective houses and all records, journals, dockets, and other 3 documents pertaining thereto; and
