1 WHEREAS, A number of Washington teachers have taught in other
2 states prior to serving in our state and have earned retirement
3 benefits in both states; and

4 WHEREAS, The benefits that these teachers will receive upon
5 retirement may be affected by the split in service between several
6 states; and

7 WHEREAS, The Joint Committee on Pension Policy was established to
8 study pension issues and make recommendations to the legislature;

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the House of Representatives of
10 the state of Washington, the Senate concurring, That the Joint
11 Committee on Pension Policy study the issue of teachers who have earned
12 retirement benefits in other states prior to teaching in Washington and
13 may have different benefits than teachers who have taught exclusively
14 in Washington; and

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Joint Committee on Pension Policy
16 report the results of this study to the legislature during the 2003-
17 2005 fiscal biennium.
