- 5 We, your Memorialists, the Senate and House of Representatives of

- 8 WHEREAS, The federal dependent care tax credit provides much needed
- 9 tax relief for the working families who place their children in
- 10 commercial day care; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Parents who choose to stay at home full time to raise
- 12 their young children are not eligible for the federal dependent care
- 13 tax credit; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Establishing a dependent care tax credit that provides
- 15 assistance to stay-at-home parents would not affect the current
- 16 dependent care tax credits for families in which both parents work; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Providing all day child care is expensive whether it is
- 18 provided in the home or by a traditional day-care operator; and
- 19 WHEREAS, The President and Congress are discussing possible tax
- 20 cuts to provide tax relief to families in order to help them meet their
- 21 needs;
