- 1 TO THE HONORABLE GARY LOCKE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- We, your Memorialists, the Senate and House of Representatives of
- 3 the State of Washington, in legislative session assembled, respectfully
- 4 represent and petition as follows:
- 5 WHEREAS, Many residents of the State of Washington work at jobs
- 6 located in Oregon; and
- 7 WHEREAS, These workers contribute significantly to the vitality of
- 8 the Washington and Oregon economies; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The States of Washington and Oregon have chosen greatly
- 10 different tax systems whereby Oregon taxes income and Washington taxes
- 11 consumption; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Washington residents pay over one hundred million dollars
- 13 in income tax to Oregon; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Clark County Washington residents pay more in personal
- 15 income tax to Oregon than do the residents of twenty-nine Oregon
- 16 counties; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Washington residents working in Oregon must pay taxes to
- 18 two states: Income taxes to Oregon and sales taxes to Washington; and
- 19 WHEREAS, The amount of income taxes paid by Washington residents to
- 20 Oregon greatly exceed the cost of public services they receive from
- 21 Oregon;
