- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 28B.10 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 The state financial aid account is created in the custody of the
- 8 state treasurer. The primary purpose of the account is to create a
- 9 reserve to ensure that all appropriations designated for financial aid
- 10 through statewide student financial aid programs are made available to
- 11 eligible students. Expenditures from the account may be used only for
- 12 financial aid to students eligible for the state need grant program,
- 13 the state work study program, the Washington scholars program, or the
- 14 Washington award for vocational excellence program. Only the executive
- 15 director of the higher education coordinating board or the executive
- 16 director's designee may authorize expenditures from the account. The
- 17 account is subject to the allotment procedures under chapter 43.88 RCW,
- 18 but an appropriation is not required for expenditures.
