- 1 AN ACT Relating to insurance coverage for certain mental illnesses;
- 2 and adding new sections to chapter 48.43 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 48.43 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) Health carriers must cover, pay for, contract for, or reimburse
- 7 for diagnosis and treatment of the following mental disorders defined
- 8 in the most current edition of the Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of
- 9 Mental Disorders published by the American psychiatric association:
- 10 (a) Schizophrenia;
- 11 (b) Schizoaffective disorder;
- 12 (c) Major depressive disorder;
- 13 (d) Bipolar disorder;
- 14 (e) Paranoid, schizoid, and schizotypal disorders;
- 15 (f) Obsessive-compulsive disorder; and
- 16 (g) Panic disorder.
- 17 (2) For purposes of this section, and sections 2 and 3 of this act,
- 18 "health carrier" or "carrier" means a disability insurer regulated
- 19 under chapter 48.20 or 48.21 RCW, a health care service contractor as

- 1 defined in RCW 48.44.010, a health maintenance organization as defined
- 2 in RCW 48.46.020, plans operating under the state health care authority
- 3 under chapter 41.05 RCW, the state health insurance pool operating
- 4 under chapters 48.41 and 70.47 RCW, and insuring entities regulated in
- 5 this chapter.
- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 48.43 RCW
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (1) Health carriers must cover, pay for, contract for, or reimburse
- 9 for diagnosis and treatment of a minor's mental condition not covered
- 10 under section 1 of this act when:
- 11 (a) The minor has accessed care from a licensed or certified mental
- 12 health practitioner on more than one occasion;
- 13 (b) The minor has been recommended for a mental health evaluation
- 14 by a probation counselor within the juvenile justice system; or
- 15 (c) The minor has been admitted to an emergency room for care and
- 16 the mental status of the minor contributed to the need for care.
- 17 (2) For purposes of this section:
- 18 (a) "Mental condition" means identification of functional
- 19 characteristics by a licensed or certified mental health practitioner
- 20 through a mental status evaluation, which indicates the minor would
- 21 likely suffer further deficit in functional characteristics without
- 22 treatment from a licensed or certified mental health practitioner.
- 23 (b) "Functional characteristics" means appearance and self-care,
- 24 sensorium, relating, affect and mood, thought and language, executive
- 25 functions, stress, and social functioning.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 48.43 RCW
- 27 to read as follows:
- 28 Under the provisions of this act, a health carrier is prohibited
- 29 from limiting benefits based on a criteria that is not applicable to
- 30 the provision of benefits for chronic medical conditions.
- 31 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** A new section is added to chapter 48.43 RCW
- 32 to read as follows:
- 33 The office of the insurance commissioner may develop rules to
- 34 implement this act.
