- AN ACT Relating to voter registration; and amending RCW 29.08.080
- 2 and 46.20.155.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 29.08.080 and 1999 c 298 s 7 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 The secretary of state shall furnish registration forms necessary
- 7 to carry out the registration of voters as provided by this chapter
- 8 without cost to the respective counties. All voter registration forms
- 9 printed after the effective date of this act must include clear and
- 10 conspicuous language, designed to draw an applicant's attention,
- 11 stating that only citizens of the United States may register to vote.
- 12 <u>Similar language must be stamped conspicuously onto existing voter</u>
- 13 registration forms in the possession of the office of the secretary of
- 14 state.
- 15 **Sec. 2.** RCW 46.20.155 and 1990 c 143 s 6 are each amended to read
- 16 as follows:
- 17 Before issuing an original license or identification card or
- 18 renewing a license or identification card under this chapter, the

- 1 licensing agent shall determine if the applicant wants to register to
- 2 vote or transfer his or her voter registration by asking the following
- 3 two questions:
- First: "Do you want to register to vote or transfer your voter
- 5 <u>registration?"</u>
- 6 Second: "Are you a United States citizen?".
- 7 If the applicant ((chooses to register or transfer a registration))
- 8 responds in the affirmative to both questions, the agent shall provide
- 9 the applicant with a voter registration form and instructions and shall
- 10 record that the applicant has requested to register to vote or transfer
- 11 a voter registration.
- 12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** If any provision of this act or its
- 13 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the
- 14 remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other
- 15 persons or circumstances is not affected.
