- 1 AN ACT Relating to safe burning cigarettes; adding a new chapter to
- 2 Title 70 RCW; creating a new section; and prescribing penalties.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. (1) The meaning attributed in chapter 82.24
- 5 RCW to the words "cigarette," "sale," "wholesaler," and "retailer"
- 6 apply equally in this chapter.
- 7 (2) "Director" means the director of fire protection appointed
- 8 under RCW 43.43.938.
- 9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** By January 1, 2003, the director of fire
- 10 protection shall adopt by rule fire safe standards for cigarettes sold
- 11 or offered for sale. The standards must ensure that:
- 12 (1) Cigarettes once ignited will stop burning within a reasonable
- 13 period of time as determined by the director; or
- 14 (2) Cigarettes will have a limited risk of igniting upholstered
- 15 furniture, mattresses, or other household furnishings as determined by
- 16 the director.

- 1 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** After June 30, 2003, no cigarettes may be
- 2 sold or offered for sale unless the manufacturer certifies in writing
- 3 to the director that the cigarettes meet the fire safe standards
- 4 adopted by the director.
- 5 The certifying manufacturer shall provide copies of the written
- 6 certification to all wholesalers and agents.
- 7 The director shall adopt by rule procedures for notifying retailers
- 8 about which cigarettes the director has certified as meeting the
- 9 standards adopted by the director.
- 10 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** Nothing in this chapter prohibits a person
- 11 or entity from selling cigarettes that have not been certified by the
- 12 manufacturer if the cigarettes are or will be stamped as being for sale
- 13 only in another state or nation.
- 14 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 5.** An agent, wholesaler, or other person who
- 15 knowingly sells cigarettes at wholesale in violation of this chapter is
- 16 subject to a civil penalty of not to exceed ten thousand dollars for
- 17 each sale of noncomplying cigarettes.
- 18 A retailer who knowingly sells or offers to sell cigarettes in
- 19 violation of this chapter is subject to a civil penalty not to exceed
- 20 five hundred dollars for each sale of or offer to sell noncomplying
- 21 cigarettes if the total number of cigarettes sold or offered for sale
- 22 exceeds one thousand cigarettes.
- In addition to other penalties provided by law, a manufacturer of
- 24 cigarettes that knowingly makes a false certification of compliance to
- 25 the director is subject to a civil penalty not to exceed ten thousand
- 26 dollars for each false certification.
- 27 The director shall deposit penalties collected under this section
- 28 into the fire service trust fund created by RCW 43.43.946, and used for
- 29 the purposes set forth in that section.
- 30 NEW SECTION. Sec. 6. The director shall adopt rules to enforce
- 31 this chapter and to recover civil penalties authorized under this
- 32 chapter.
- 33 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 7.** (1) The director shall report to the senate
- 34 and house labor and commerce committees by September 1, 2003, regarding
- 35 the status of rule making.

- 1 (2) The director shall consult with the director of health to 2 consider whether cigarettes manufactured in accordance with section 2 3 of this act may result in increased health risks to consumers.
- 4 (3) By January 1, 2004, the director shall report to the senate and 5 house labor and commerce committees about whether cigarettes 6 manufactured in accordance with section 2 of this act result in 7 increased health risks to consumers.
- 8 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 8.** Sections 1 through 6 of this act constitute 9 a new chapter in Title 70 RCW.
