- AN ACT Relating to allowing county chairs to vote at political 1
- 2 party state committee meetings; and amending RCW 29.42.020.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 29.42.020 and 1987 c 295 s 11 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- The state committee of each major political party shall consist of 6
- 7 one committeeman ((and)), one committeewoman, and the chairman from
- each county elected by the county committee at its organization 8
- 9
- It shall have a chair and vice-chair who must be of opposite
- 10 sexes. This committee shall meet during January of each odd-numbered
- year for the purpose of organization at a time and place designated by 11
- 12 a sufficient notice to all the newly elected state committeemen
- ((and)), committeewomen, and chairmen by the authorized officers of the 13
- retiring committee. For the purpose of this section a notice mailed at 14
- 15 least one week prior to the date of the meeting shall constitute
- 16 sufficient notice. At its organizational meeting it shall elect its
- chair and vice-chair, and such officers as its bylaws may provide, and 17
- 18 adopt bylaws, rules and regulations. It shall have power to:

- 1 (1) Call conventions at such time and place and under such 2 circumstances and for such purposes as the call to convention shall 3 designate. The manner, number and procedure for selection of state 4 convention delegates shall be subject to the committee's rules and 5 regulations duly adopted;
 - (2) Provide for the election of delegates to national conventions;
- 7 (3) Fill vacancies on the ticket for any federal or state office to 8 be voted on by the electors of more than one county;
 - (4) Provide for the nomination of presidential electors; and
- 10 (5) Perform all functions inherent in such an organization.

Notwithstanding any provision of this chapter, the committee shall not set rules which shall govern the conduct of the actual proceedings at a party state convention.
