- 1 AN ACT Relating to requirements for providing transportation
- 2 funding; and adding a new section to chapter 47.05 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 47.05 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) The department, in cooperation with local governments, shall
- 7 direct a baseline allocation of funding to operations, maintenance,
- 8 preservation, and safety functions for state highways, county roads,
- 9 city streets, transit, ferries, and alternate modes.
- 10 (2) As a condition of receiving the baseline allocation of funding
- 11 established in subsection (1) of this section, all agencies and
- 12 jurisdictions must demonstrate the use of maintenance management
- 13 systems and pavement management systems to the legislature.
- 14 (3) As a condition of receiving any funding, the department,
- 15 cities, and counties must demonstrate, after an initial period of three
- 16 years, that their preservation investments are based on lowest life
- 17 cycle cost principles.

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- 1 (4) Available grant programs must not be used to fund preservation
- 2 projects that are already funded from baseline fund allocations.

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
