- 8 A judge of the supreme court shall be admitted to the practice
- 9 of law in the courts of record of this state not less than fifteen
- 10 years prior to taking office.
- 11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 2.08 RCW
- 12 to read as follows:
- 13 A judge of a superior court shall be admitted to the practice
- 14 of law in the courts of record of this state not less than five
- 15 years prior to taking office.

17 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** If a judge currently holding office does

- 1 not meet the minimum qualifications specified in this act on the
- 2 effective date of this act, the judge may complete his or her
- 3 current term of office.
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** This act takes effect thirty days after
- 5 election if the proposed amendment to Article IV, section 17 of
- 6 the state Constitution specifying qualifications for judges is
- 7 validly submitted to and is approved and ratified by the voters at
- 8 the next general election. If the proposed amendment is not
- 9 approved and ratified, this act is void in its entirety.
