- The codes referenced in subsections (1) through (5) of this
 section that are adopted by the state, counties, or cities of
 Washington shall not be amended to be more restrictive than these
 enumerated model codes.
- In case of conflict among the codes enumerated in subsections (1), (2), (3), and (4) of this section, the first named code shall govern over those following.
- 25 The codes enumerated in this section shall be adopted by the 26 council as provided in RCW 19.27.074.
- The council may issue opinions relating to the codes at the request of a local official charged with the duty to enforce the enumerated codes.
