NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. For the purposes of determining the number 1 2 of shellfish pots assigned to a Washington Dungeness crab-coastal 3 fishery license, if the Dungeness crab-coastal fishery license is held by a person whose vessel was lost due to sinking or fire in 4 5 any one of the three qualifying seasons, then the department of fish and wildlife shall go back one more season from December 1, 6 7 1995, to September 15, 1996, and use this season poundage to 8 determine the number of pots granted to the license holder as an exception to WAC 220-52-040(14).
