1 AN ACT Relating to shoreline master plans; and adding a new section
2 to chapter 90.58 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 90.58 RCW
5 to read as follows:

6 The legislature endorses the shoreline management act guidelines
7 adopted by the department in November 2000.

8 Cities and counties that are in an evolutionarily significant unit
9 with salmonid species listed as threatened or endangered under the
10 federal endangered species act (16 U.S.C. Sec. 1531 et seq.) by the
11 national marine fisheries service must follow "path B" of the
12 guidelines.

13 Cities and counties that are in an evolutionarily significant unit
14 with salmonid species listed as threatened or endangered under the
15 federal endangered species act (16 U.S.C. Sec. 1531 et seq.) by the
16 national marine fisheries service must update their shoreline master
17 plans within two years of the date of adoption of the guidelines.
