- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that the operations of
  - the local, state, and federal government and the roles of individual
- policymakers are often not understood by citizens. Yet public
- understanding of the institutions and processes of government is 8
- 9 critical to a healthy democracy and the building of public trust and
- 10 confidence in our elected officials. The legislature further finds
- that civic education through our public schools is a vital tool to 11
