- 1 AN ACT Relating to tax relief for agricultural businesses; adding
- 2 a new section to chapter 82.04 RCW; and declaring an emergency.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 82.04 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) In computing the tax imposed under this chapter, a credit is allowed for the amount of taxes otherwise due under this chapter for businesses essential to agriculture whose business substantially 8 9 involves the sale of equipment or supplies to farmers, and the business 10 has gross income from the business or gross proceeds from sales that
- have decreased because of the 2001 drought by seven percent or more 11
- 12 from the same reporting period the year before.
- 13 (2) The credit equals seven percent multiplied by the gross 14 proceeds from sales or gross income from the business during the same 15 reporting period for the prior year.
- (3) Application for the credit shall be made in the form and manner 16 17 prescribed by the department. A person taking the credit must keep records necessary for the department to verify eligibility under this 18

- 1 section. No tax credit may be claimed for periods prior to April 2001
- 2 and after July 2002.
- 3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** This act is necessary for the immediate
- 4 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
- 5 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect
- 6 immediately.
