1 AN ACT Relating to group fishing permits; adding a new section to
2 chapter 77.32 RCW; and repealing RCW 77.32.235.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 77.32 RCW
5 to read as follows:

6 A group fishing permit allows a group of individuals to fish and
7 harvest shellfish without individual licenses or the payment of
8 individual license fees. The director may issue a group fishing permit
9 to a licensed, state-operated, or nonprofit facility that serves
10 physically or mentally disabled persons, mentally ill persons, hospital
11 patients, handicapped persons, seriously or terminally ill persons, or
12 senior citizens.

13 The commission must adopt rules that provide the conditions under
14 which a group fishing permit may be issued.

1 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** RCW 77.32.235 (Group permits--Exemption from
2 individual license and fee requirement--Conditions) and 1998 c 191 s
3 20, 1990 c 35 s 4, & 1984 c 33 s 1 are each repealed.
