- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 80.28.068 and 1999 c 62 s 1 are each amended to read 6 as follows:
- 7 Upon request by an electrical or gas company, the commission may
- 8 approve rates, charges, services, and/or physical facilities at a
- 9 discount for low-income senior customers and low-income customers. The
- 10 attorney general may also file a request for such a discount program if
- 11 the company does not have an existing program approved under this
- 12 <u>section</u>. Expenses and lost revenues as a result of these discounts
- 13 shall be included in the company's cost of service and recovered in
- 14 rates to other customers by means of a charge set forth in a separate
- 15 schedule to the company's tariffs. The filing of a request under this
- 16 section shall not constitute a general rate increase filing as defined
