1 AN ACT Relating to agricultural liens; and amending RCW 60.13.060.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

3 **Sec. 1.** RCW 60.13.060 and 1987 c 148 s 5 are each amended to read
4 as follows:

5 (1) The processor lien shall terminate (~~((six))~~) twenty-four months
6 after, and the preparer lien shall terminate fifty days after, the
7 later of the date of attachment or filing, unless a suit to foreclose
8 the lien has been filed before that time as provided in RCW 60.13.070.

9 (2) If a statement has been filed as provided in RCW 60.13.040 and
10 the producer or commercial (~~((fisherman))~~) fisher has received payment
11 for the obligation secured by the lien, the producer or (~~((fisherman))~~)
12 fisher shall promptly file with the department of licensing a statement
13 declaring that full payment has been received and that the lien is
14 discharged. If, after payment, the producer or (~~((fisherman))~~) fisher
15 fails to file such statement of discharge within ten days following a
16 request to do so, the producer or (~~((fisherman))~~) fisher shall be liable

1 to the processor, conditioner, or preparer in the sum of one hundred
2 dollars plus actual damages caused by the failure.

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
