- 2 in city or town police departments; and adding a new section to chapter

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 41.12 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (1) The classified civil service and provisions of this chapter
- 8 include all certified police officers and other employees of the police
- 9 department in each city or town except the chief and an additional
- 10 number of positions, designated the unclassified service, in every city
- 11 or town determined as follows:

2 (2) The unclassified position appointments authorized by this section must include selections from the following positions up to the 3 limit of the number of positions authorized: Assistant chief, deputy 4 chief, bureau commander, and administrative assistant or administrative 5 secretary. The initial selection of specific positions to be exempt б 7 shall be made by the chief, who shall notify the civil service Subsequent changes in the 8 commission of his or her selection. designation of which positions are to be exempt may be made only with 9 the concurrence of the chief, mayor or city administrator, and the 10 civil service commission, and then only after the civil service 11 12 commission has heard the issue in open meeting. Should the position or positions initially selected by the chief to be exempt, as unclassified 13 under this section, be under the classified civil service at the time 14 of the selection, and should the position be occupied, the employee 15 16 occupying the position has the right to return to the next highest 17 position or a like position under classified civil service.

In those cities and towns in which the chief of police is a mandated civil service position, this section does not apply.

(3) The classified civil service and provisions of this chapter include all full paid employees of the police department of each city, town, or municipality coming within its purview, except those individuals appointed as police chief and the executive staff personnel, including the assistant chief, deputy chief, bureau commander, and administrative assistant or administrative secretary to a department with six or more commissioned officers, including the police chief. All appointments to and promotions in the department shall be made solely on merit, efficiency, and fitness except as provided in RCW 35.13.360 through 35.13.400, which shall be ascertained by open competitive examination and impartial investigation. No person shall be reinstated in or transferred, suspended, or discharged from any such place, position, or employment contrary to the provisions of this chapter except those exempted positions.
