- 1 AN ACT Relating to time-loss payments; and adding a new section to
- 2 chapter 51.32 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 51.32 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 An injured worker is entitled to time-loss payments, if any are
- 7 authorized by the department, in an amount fifteen percent larger than
- 8 would otherwise be allowed if:
- 9 (1) The injured worker claims and can show to the director's
- 10 satisfaction that the injury suffered is the result of the employer's
- 11 failure to follow a safety rule issued or enforced under Title 49 RCW;
- 12 and
- 13 (2) The director finds that the employer has engaged in a
- 14 consistent pattern or practice of serious, willful, or nonabated safety
- 15 violations.
