- 3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 82.12 RCW 4 to read as follows:
- 5 The tax levied by RCW 82.08.020 shall not apply to the use of
- 6 medical supplies, chemicals, or materials by an organ procurement
- 7 organization exempt under section 1 of this act. The definitions of
- 8 medical supplies, chemicals, and materials in RCW 82.04.324 apply to
- 9 this section. This exemption does not apply to the use of construction
- 10 materials, office equipment, building equipment, administrative
- 11 supplies, or vehicles.
- 12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** This act is necessary for the immediate
- 13 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
- 14 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect
- 15 immediately.
