- 1 AN ACT Relating to authorizing the increase of personal use
- 2 shellfish license fees to fund biotoxin testing and monitoring by the
- 3 department of health of beaches used for recreational shellfishing;
- 4 adding a new section to chapter 77.32 RCW; creating new sections; and
- 5 declaring an emergency.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 7 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that testing and
- 8 monitoring of beaches used for recreational shellfishing is essential
- 9 to ensure the health of recreational shellfishers. The legislature
- 10 also finds that it is essential to have a stable and reliable source of
- 11 funding for such biotoxin testing and monitoring. The legislature also
- 12 finds that the cost of the resident and nonresident personal use
- 13 shellfish and seaweed licenses is undervalued and not properly aligned
- 14 with neighboring states and provinces.
- 15 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 77.32 RCW
- 16 to read as follows:
- 17 In addition to the fees authorized in this chapter, the department
- 18 shall include a surcharge to fund biotoxin testing and monitoring by

- 1 the department of health of beaches used for recreational shellfishing.
- 2 A surcharge of two dollars applies to the following licenses: (1)
- 3 Resident and nonresident shellfish and seaweed licenses as authorized
- 4 by RCW 77.32.520(2)(a); and (2) resident and nonresident adult
- 5 combination licenses as authorized by RCW 77.32.470(2)(a). Amounts
- 6 collected from this surcharge must be deposited in the general fund--
- 7 local account managed by the department of health.
- 8 Amounts in excess of the annual costs of the department of health
- 9 recreational shellfish testing and monitoring program shall be
- 10 transferred to the general fund by the department of health.
- 11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** The fee increase proposed in this act must
- 12 be implemented in the department of fish and wildlife's license fee
- 13 structure for the license year beginning April 1, 2002.
- 14 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** This act is necessary for the immediate
- 15 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
- 16 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect
- 17 immediately.
