State of Washington 57th Legislature 2001 Regular Session

By Senators Jacobsen, Kohl-Welles, Carlson and Rasmussen Read first time 04/03/2001. Referred to Committee on Higher Education.

1 WHEREAS, Opportunities for students to attend institutions of 2 higher education are important to the future of the State of 3 Washington; and

4 WHEREAS, For many students, the opportunity to attend colleges and 5 universities depends upon tuition levels, financial aid, and 6 scholarships; and

7 WHEREAS, Both the public and private sectors of the state of Washington, together with the community, should strengthen their opportunity to support, jointly and individually, higher education in 10 Washington state;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Senate of the State of 11 12 Washington, the House of Representatives concurring, That a blue ribbon 13 task force be established on expanding scholarship and financial aid for higher education students in Washington State; and 14

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the task force shall study tuition, 15 16 the availability of federal and state financial aid, scholarships, and 17 the effects of tax deductions for tuition and student loans; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the task force shall consist of two 18 19 members each from the minority and majority caucuses of the Senate and the minority and majority caucuses of the House of Representatives; and 20

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the legislature requests that the 1 following entities nominate members to serve on the task force as 2 follows: One member each from the board of regents of the University 3 4 of Washington and of Washington State University, one member from each board of trustees from the regional institutions of higher education 5 and The Evergreen State College, three members representing the 6 7 community and technical colleges of Washington State, three members 8 representing the private institutions of higher education in Washington 9 State, three students selected by the Washington Student Lobby, one 10 representative of the higher education coordinating board, one representative of the state board for community and technical colleges, 11 and four members of the community nominated by the legislative members 12 of the task force; and 13

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the task force shall report its findings and recommendations to the legislature no later than December 15, 2001.
