READ FIRST TIME 04/04/01. UNDER SUSPENSION OF THE RULES, PLACED ON THE SECOND READING CALENDAR.

1       WHEREAS, Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 8402 established cutoff  
2 dates for consideration of legislation during the 2001 Regular Session  
3 of the Fifty-Seventh Legislature;

4       NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Senate of the State of  
5 Washington, the House of Representatives concurring, That the cutoff  
6 dates established in Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 8402 be amended  
7 as follows:

8       That after 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 12, 2001, the ninety-fifth  
9 day, neither house may consider any bills, memorials, or joint  
10 resolutions except initiatives to the legislature and alternatives to  
11 such initiatives, messages pertaining to amendments, matters of  
12 differences between the two houses, and matters incident to the interim  
13 and to the closing of the business of the 2001 Regular Session of the  
14 Legislature.
