READ FIRST TIME 01/14/02. UNDER SUSPENSION OF RULES, READ SECOND AND THIRD TIMES AND ADOPTED.

1 WHEREAS, Bills, joint resolutions, joint memorials, and concurrent
2 resolutions introduced at the 2001 regular and special sessions of the
3 Fifty-seventh Legislature may require that they be considered at the
4 2002 regular session of the Fifty-seventh Legislature; and

5 WHEREAS, The public interest requires that the business of the 2002
6 regular session of the Fifty-seventh Legislature be considered and
7 acted upon as efficiently and expeditiously as possible;

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Senate, the House of
9 Representatives concurring, That all bills, joint resolutions, joint
10 memorials, and concurrent resolutions introduced in the 2001 regular
11 and special sessions of the Fifty-seventh Legislature are reintroduced
12 in the house in which they originated and will retain the same number
13 and be given the legislative status that they held in the original
14 house as shown by the official House and Senate dockets upon the
15 adjournment SINE DIE of the 2001 third special session.
