- BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON, IN LEGISLATIVE SESSION ASSEMBLED:
- 3 THAT, At the next general election to be held in this state the 4 secretary of state shall submit to the qualified voters of the state 5 for their approval and ratification, or rejection, an amendment to 6 Article 7 of the Constitution of the state of Washington by adding a
- 7 new section to read as follows:
- 8 Article 7, section . . . (1) Notwithstanding any other provision
- 9 of this Constitution, the legislature may, by appropriate legislation,
- 10 grant to property owners an exemption from property taxes levied for
- 11 state purposes equal to fifty thousand dollars of valuation and a
- 12 credit from property taxes levied for state purposes equal to the state
- 13 property tax on fifty thousand dollars of valuation, to be applied to
- 14 property owned by the taxpayer beginning with taxes payable in 2003.
- 15 (2) The legislature may provide for an increase in either or both
- 16 the exemption and the credit each year after 2003 by the change in
- 17 state personal income for the previous year.
- 18 (3) The exemption and credit authorized in this section are in
- 19 addition to any tax relief under Article VII, section 10.
