- BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON, IN LEGISLATIVE SESSION ASSEMBLED:
- 3 THAT, At the next general election to be held in this state the 4 secretary of state shall submit to the qualified voters of the state 5 for their approval and ratification, or rejection, an amendment to 6 Article VIII of the Constitution of the state of Washington by adding
- 7 a new section to read as follows:
- 8 Article VIII, section . . . The state treasurer shall transfer
- 9 into an emergency reserve fund one-half of one percent of general
- 10 fund--state revenue collections from July 1, 2003, through June 30,
- 11 2004, one percent from July 1, 2004, through June 30, 2005, and one and
- 12 one-half percent thereafter. During any fiscal biennium, the
- 13 accumulated balance in the fund shall never exceed the equivalent of
- 14 five percent of that biennium's general fund--state revenues. Any
- 15 balance in excess of five percent shall be transferred by the state
- 16 treasurer to another account for use after appropriation for one-time
- 17 costs of construction and equipment for common school purposes.
- 18 All withdrawals from the emergency reserve fund shall be pursuant
- 19 to a declaration of emergency by the governor and approval by
- 20 two-thirds of the membership of each house of the legislature.
- 21 To the extent inconsistent, this fund shall supersede the emergency

- 1 reserve fund previously established by statute.
- 2 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the secretary of state shall cause
- 3 notice of this constitutional amendment to be published at least four
- 4 times during the four weeks next preceding the election in every legal
- 5 newspaper in the state.
