READ FIRST TIME 03/05/01. UNDER SUSPENSION OF THE RULES, READ SECOND AND THIRD TIMES AND ADOPTED.

1 WHEREAS, Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 8402 established cutoff
2 dates for consideration of legislation during the 2001 Regular Session
3 of the Fifty-Seventh Legislature;

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Senate of the State of
5 Washington, the House of Representatives concurring, That the cutoff
6 dates established in Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 8402 be amended
7 as follows:

8 (1) Monday, March 5, 2001, the fifty-seventh day, will be the final
9 day to read in Senate Bill committee reports in the Senate with the
10 exception of reports from the Senate Ways and Means and Senate
11 Transportation committees; and

12 (2) Thursday, March 8, 2001, the sixtieth day, will be the final
13 day to read in Senate Ways and Means, Senate Transportation, and House
14 of Representatives fiscal committee reports in the house of origin.
