Brief Description: Clarifying the cost burden for utility relocation.

HB 2193-S - DIGEST

(DIGEST OF PROPOSED 1ST SUBSTITUTE)

Provides that, if utility facilities must be removed or relocated as a result of the construction, alteration, repair, or improvement of a system, the costs of the removal or relocation must be included in the costs of the system and paid by the authority.

Declares that, in no case is the owner, lessee, or occupant of the utility facilities responsible for the costs. For purposes of this act, "utility facilities" include, but are not limited to, cable television, gas, electric, and telecommunications facilities.
