Brief Description: Regulating use of DNA in insurance transactions.

**SB 5282-S - DIGEST**

(AS OF SENATE 2ND READING 3/09/01)

Declares that a person's deoxyribonucleic acid shall not be screened in any insurance transaction.

Declares that the act must not be interpreted to deny payment of claims, and limited DNA information, not the entire DNA code or sequence, may be communicated to an insurer for purposes of documenting the obligation to pay the claim.
