Brief Description: Requiring informed consent before a person's DNA
is used for genetic testing.

SB 5284-S - DIGEST

(AS OF SENATE 2ND READING 3/12/01)

Provides that any entity, including any person, isolating a
person's deoxyribonucleic acid in a form that identifies an
individual person for purposes of genetic testing must have the
person's informed consent.

Designates exceptions to required consent.
