## EFFECT:

- Requires the Department of Labor and Industries to report to the Senate Commerce and Trade Committee and to the House Commerce and Labor Committee by December 1, 2005, on the implementation of the act, including the effects of the act on injured worker outcomes, claim costs, and disputed claims.
  - Ø Adds an effective date and an expiration date for the section giving physician assistants authority to execute accident report forms for industrial injuries.
