EFFECT: Makes a technical correction for an inadvertly omitted adjustment to the appropriations made for contributions to the law enforcement officers' and fire fighters' retirement system. The adjustment is for lower than projected contribution requirements for FY 2004 and higher than projected requirements for FY 2005 than was forecasted in the 2003-05 biennial budget.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Reduces General Fund-State (FY 2004) by \$1,000,000 Increases General Fund-State (FY 2005) by \$500,000.
