4 HEALTH CARE POLICY TECHNICAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE

5 NEW SECTION. Sec. 101. RCW 41.05.150 (Health care policy
6 technical advisory committee) and 1988 c 107 s 14 are each repealed.

7 PART 2

8 GOVERNOR'S SMALL BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT COUNCIL

9 NEW SECTION. Sec. 201. The following acts or parts of acts are
10 each repealed:

11 (1) RCW 43.175.010 (Governor's small business improvement council--
12 Established--Membership--Travel expenses--Staff support and
13 administrative assistance) and 1987 c 348 s 6, 1985 c 466 s 62, & 1984
14 c 282 s 7;

15 (2) RCW 43.175.020 (Duties) and 1998 c 245 s 53, 1987 c 348 s 7,
16 1985 c 466 s 63, & 1984 c 282 s 8; and

17 (3) RCW 43.175.901 (Severability--1984 c 282) and 1984 c 282 s 17.

19 REBUILDING FAMILIES ADVISORY COMMITTEE

20 NEW SECTION. Sec. 301. By July 1, 2003, the secretary of the
21 department of corrections shall abolish the rebuilding families
22 advisory committee.

23 PART 4

1 (5) Work with individuals or organizations who wish to volunteer
2 their time to support the water trail recreation program.

3 **Sec. 602.** RCW 79A.05.400 and 1993 c 182 s 5 are each amended to
4 read as follows:

5 A person may not participate as a user of the water trail
6 recreation program without first obtaining a water trail permit. A
7 person must renew this permit on an annual basis in order to continue
8 to participate as a user of the program. The fee for the issuance of
9 the statewide water trail permit for each year shall be determined by
10 the commission (~~((after consultation with the water trail advisory~~
11 ~~committee))). All statewide water trail permits shall expire on the
12 last day of December of the year for which the permit is issued.~~

13 **Sec. 603.** RCW 79A.05.410 and 1993 c 182 s 7 are each amended to
14 read as follows:

15 The commission may(~~(, after consultation with the water trail~~
16 ~~advisory committee,)) adopt rules to administer the water trail program
17 and facilities on areas owned or administered by the commission. Where
18 water trail facilities administered by other public or private entities
19 are incorporated into the water trail system, the rules adopted by
20 those entities shall prevail. The commission is not responsible or
21 liable for enforcement of these alternative rules.~~

22 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 604.** RCW 79A.05.420 (Water trail advisory
23 committee) and 2000 c 11 s 41, 1994 c 264 s 21, & 1993 c 182 s 9 are
24 each repealed.

25 PART 7

26 COMMUNITY OUTDOOR ATHLETIC FIELDS ADVISORY COUNCIL

27 **Sec. 701.** RCW 79A.25.800 and 2000 c 11 s 80 are each amended to
28 read as follows:

29 (1) The legislature recognizes that coordinated funding efforts are
30 needed to maintain, develop, and improve the state's community outdoor
31 athletic fields. Rapid population growth and increased urbanization
32 have caused a decline in suitable outdoor fields for community athletic
33 activities and has resulted in overcrowding and deterioration of

1 existing surfaces. Lack of adequate community outdoor athletic fields
2 directly affects the health and well-being of all citizens of the
3 state, reduces the state's economic viability, and prevents Washington
4 from maintaining and achieving the quality of life that it deserves.
5 Therefore, it is the policy of the state and its agencies to maintain,
6 develop, fund, and improve youth or community athletic facilities,
7 including but not limited to community outdoor athletic fields.

8 (2) In carrying out this policy, the legislature intends to promote
9 the building of new community outdoor athletic fields, the upgrading of
10 existing community outdoor athletic fields, and the maintenance of
11 existing community outdoor athletic fields across the state of
12 Washington. (~~The purpose of RCW 79A.25.800 through 79A.25.830 is to
13 create an advisory council to provide information and advice to the
14 interagency committee for outdoor recreation in the distribution of the
15 funds in the youth athletic facility grant account established in RCW
16 43.99N.060(4).~~)

17 **Sec. 702.** RCW 79A.25.820 and 2000 c 11 s 81 are each amended to
18 read as follows:

19 Subject to available resources, the interagency committee for
20 outdoor recreation(~~(, in consultation with the community outdoor
21 athletic fields advisory council)~~) may:

22 (1) Prepare and update a strategic plan for the development,
23 maintenance, and improvement of community outdoor athletic fields in
24 the state. In the preparation of such plan, the interagency committee
25 for outdoor recreation may use available data from federal, state, and
26 local agencies having community outdoor athletic responsibilities, user
27 groups, private sector interests, and the general public. The plan may
28 include, but is not limited to:

29 (a) An inventory of current community outdoor athletic fields;

30 (b) A forecast of demand for these fields;

31 (c) An identification and analysis of actual and potential funding
32 sources; and

33 (d) Other information the interagency committee for outdoor
34 recreation deems appropriate to carry out the purposes of RCW
35 79A.25.800 through 79A.25.830;

36 (2) Determine the eligibility requirements for cities, counties,

1 and qualified nonprofit organizations to access funding from the youth
2 athletic facility ((grant)) account created in RCW 43.99N.060(4);

3 (3) Encourage and provide opportunities for interagency and
4 regional coordination and cooperative efforts between public agencies
5 and between public entities and nonprofit organizations involved in the
6 maintenance, development, and improvement of community outdoor athletic
7 fields; and

8 (4) Create and maintain data, studies, research, and other
9 information relating to community outdoor athletic fields in the state,
10 and to encourage the exchange of this information.

11 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 703.** RCW 79A.25.810 (Community outdoor athletic
12 fields advisory council) and 2001 c 245 s 1 & 1998 c 264 s 2 are each
13 repealed.

14 **PART 8**

15 **ARTHRITIS ADVISORY GROUP**

16 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 801.** By July 1, 2003, the secretary of the
17 department of health shall abolish the arthritis advisory group.

18 **PART 9**

19 **COMMITTEE ON TAXATION AND**
20 **ADVISORY GROUP TO THE COMMITTEE ON TAXATION**

21 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 901.** By July 1, 2003, the director of revenue
22 shall abolish the committee on taxation and the advisory group to the
23 committee on taxation created by section 137(1), chapter 371, Laws of
24 2002.

25 **PART 10**

26 **MISCELLANEOUS**

27 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1001.** Part headings used in this act are not
28 any part of the law.

29 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1002.** Sections 701 and 702 of this act expire
30 one year after RCW 82.14.0494 expires.

1 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1003.** This act is necessary for the immediate
2 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
3 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect
4 July 1, 2003."

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5 On page 1, line 1 of the title, after "commissions;" strike the
6 remainder of the title and insert "amending RCW 79A.05.385, 79A.05.400,
7 79A.05.410, 79A.25.800, and 79A.25.820; creating new sections;
8 repealing RCW 41.05.150, 43.175.010, 43.175.020, 43.175.901,
9 79A.05.420, and 79A.25.810; providing an effective date; providing a
10 contingent expiration date; and declaring an emergency."

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
