- "NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. (1) The legislature finds that the voters 3 4 of the state expressed their support for home-based long-term care 5 services through their approval of Initiative Measure No. 775 in 2001. 6 With passage of the initiative, the state has been directed to increase 7 the quality of state-funded long-term care services provided to elderly 8 and disabled persons in their own homes through recruitment and 9 training of in-home individual providers, referral of qualified individual providers to seniors and persons with disabilities seeking 10 11 a provider, and stabilization of the individual provider work force. 12 The legislature further finds that the quality of care our elders and 13 people with disabilities receive is highly dependent upon the quality 14 and stability of the individual provider work force, and that the demand for the services of these providers will increase as our 15 16 population ages.
- legislature intends to stabilize the 17 (2)state-funded 18 individual provider work force by providing funding to implement the collective bargaining agreement between the home care quality authority 19 and the exclusive bargaining representative of individual providers. 20 21 The agreement reflects the value and importance of the work done by 22 individual providers to support the needs of elders and people with disabilities in Washington state.

- 24 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. The sum of one hundred forty-five thousand 25 dollars, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from 26 the general fund--state for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2005, and 27 the sum of one hundred forty-five thousand dollars, or as much thereof 28 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the general fund--federal for 29 the biennium ending June 30, 2005, to the children and family services 30 program of the department of social and health services. The

appropriations in this section shall be used solely to implement the compensation-related provisions of the collective bargaining agreement between the home care quality authority and the exclusive bargaining representative of the individual providers of home care services. The appropriations in this section shall be reduced by any amounts appropriated by the 2004 legislature for this purpose in separate legislation enacted prior to June 30, 2004.

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** The sum of eight million ninety-six thousand dollars, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the general fund--state for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2005, and the sum of seven million five hundred thirty-one thousand dollars, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the general fund--federal for the biennium ending June 30, 2005, the developmental disabilities program of the department of social and The appropriations in this section shall be used health services. implement the compensation-related provisions of collective bargaining agreement between the home care quality authority and the exclusive bargaining representative of the individual providers of home care services. The appropriations in this section shall be used solely to implement the compensation-related provisions of the collective bargaining agreement between the home care quality authority and the exclusive bargaining representative of the individual providers of home care services. The appropriations in this section shall be reduced by any amounts appropriated by the 2004 legislature for this purpose in separate legislation enacted prior to June 30, 2004.

NEW SECTION. Sec. 5. The sum of ninety-four thousand dollars, or 1 2 as much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the general fund--state for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2004, and the sum of 3 one million two hundred seventy-six thousand dollars, or as much 4 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the general fund--5 state for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2005, to the home care 6 7 quality authority. The appropriations in this section shall be used solely for administrative and employer relations costs associated with 8 implementing the terms of the collective bargaining agreement between 9 10 home care quality authority and the exclusive bargaining representative of the individual providers of home care services. 11 12 quality authority shall transfer funds from 13 appropriation to the department of social and health services and to 14 the office of financial management as necessary to achieve the terms of the agreement. The appropriations in this section shall be reduced by 15 16 any amounts appropriated by the 2004 legislature for this purpose in separate legislation enacted prior to June 30, 2004. 17

NEW SECTION. Sec. 6. The sum of thirteen thousand dollars, or as 18 much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the general 19 20 fund--state for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2004, and the sum of 21 fifty-two thousand dollars, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the general fund--state for the fiscal year ending 22 23 2005, to the office of financial management. appropriations in this section shall be used solely for administrative 24 and employer relations costs associated with implementing Substitute 25 26 House Bill No. 2933 (home care worker collective bargaining). 27 appropriations in this section shall be reduced by any amounts appropriated by the 2004 legislature for this purpose in separate 28 29 legislation enacted prior to June 30, 2004.

NEW SECTION. Sec. 7. This act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect immediately."
