

SHB 1829 - S AMD 303

1 On page 10, beginning on line 35, after "and" strike all material
2 down to and including "retirement." on line 10 and insert the
3 following:

4 "(d) The employee has not already rendered a cumulative total of
5 more than (i) three thousand one hundred sixty-five hours of service as
6 a teacher or principal, or (ii) one thousand nine hundred hours in any
7 other capacity, while receiving pension payments, beyond an annual
8 threshold of eight hundred sixty-seven hours;
9 shall cease to receive pension payments while engaged in that service
10 after the retiree has rendered service for more than one thousand five
11 hundred hours in a school year. The cumulative total limitations under
12 this subsection apply prospectively to those retiring after the
13 effective date of this act and retroactively to those who retired prior
14 to the effective date of this act, and shall be calculated from the
15 date of retirement."

EFFECT: Increases from 1,900 hours to 3,165 hours the lifetime cumulative limit on the hours that teachers' retirement system plan 1 retirees may work in excess of 867 hours per year as teachers or principals while receiving pension benefits. For teachers and principals working on a full-time basis, this extends the limit from three years to five years.
