1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the
2 following:

3 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 9.41 RCW
4 to read as follows:

5 (1)(a) A person licensed to carry a handgun in a state the laws of
6 which recognize and give effect in that state to a concealed pistol
7 license issued under the laws of the state of Washington is authorized
8 to carry a pistol in this state if:

9 (i) The licensing state does not issue concealed pistol licenses to
10 persons under twenty-one years of age; and

11 (ii) The licensing state requires mandatory background checks for
12 all persons who apply for a concealed pistol license.

13 (b) This section applies to a license holder from another state
14 only while the license holder is not a resident of this state. A
15 license holder from another state must carry the handgun in compliance
16 with the laws of this state.

17 (2) The attorney general shall periodically publish a list of
18 states the laws of which recognize and give effect in that state to a
19 concealed pistol license issued under the laws of the state of
20 Washington."

21 On page 1, line 2 of the title, after "states;" strike the
22 remainder of the title and insert "and adding a new section to chapter
23 9.41 RCW."

EFFECT: An out-of-state CPL is only recognized if the licensing state requires a license holder to be 21 or older and requires background checks for all persons applying for a concealed pistol license.
