On page 86, line 36, strike the appropriation and insert "\$59,506,000".

1 On page 89, on line 6, strike all of subsection (9) through line  
2 12, and insert the following: "(9) \$238,000 of the state toxics control  
3 account " state appropriation is provided solely to (a) implement the  
4 mercury chemical action plan; (b) fund rulemaking to select future  
5 chemicals for action plans; and (c) provide ongoing funding for  
6 development and implementation of future chemical action plans. Any  
7 pesticide with a valid registration on or after the effective date of  
8 this act issued by the environmental protection agency under the  
9 federal insecticide, fungicide and rodenticide act, 7 U.S.C. 136 et  
10 seq, or any fertilizer regulated under the Washington fertilizer act,  
11 RCW 15.54, shall not be included in a persistent bioaccumulative toxin  
12 rulemaking process, list, or chemical action plan undertaken by the  
13 department of ecology."

14 Renumber the sections consecutively and correct any internal  
15 references accordingly.
