**Brief Summary of Bill**

- The Transportation Commission is requested to designate the 320th Street crossing of Interstate Five in the city of Federal Way the "Maryann Mitchell Memorial Interchange."

**Background:**

In the past the Legislature has designated certain portions of the state highway system with memorial names. More recently, the Transportation Commission (Commission) established a policy and developed a process for designating memorials on the state highway system when requested to do so by the Legislature. Upon legislative request, the Commission will adopt a resolution directing the Department of Transportation (DOT) to carry out the designation of the facility with the memorial name.
