- 1 AN ACT Relating to use tax on motor homes; and amending RCW
- 2 82.12.0251.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 82.12.0251 and 1997 c 301 s 1 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- The provisions of this chapter shall not apply in respect to the 6 7 use of any article of tangible personal property brought into the state 8 of Washington by a nonresident thereof for his or her use or enjoyment while temporarily within the state of Washington unless such property 9 10 is used in conducting a nontransitory business activity within the 11 state of Washington; or in respect to the use by a nonresident of Washington of a motor vehicle or trailer which is registered or 12 licensed under the laws of the state of his or her residence, and which 13 is not required to be registered or licensed under the laws of 14 Washington, including motor vehicles or trailers exempt pursuant to a 15 declaration issued by the department of licensing under RCW 46.85.060; 16 or in respect to the use of household goods, personal effects, and 17 private motor vehicles, not including motor homes, by a bona fide 18 19 resident of Washington, or nonresident members of the armed forces who

are stationed in Washington pursuant to military orders, if such 1 2 articles were acquired and used by such person in another state while a bona fide resident thereof and such acquisition and use occurred more 3 than ninety days prior to the time he or she entered Washington; or in 4 respect to the use of a motor home by a bona fide resident of 5 Washington, or nonresident members of the armed forces who are 6 7 stationed in Washington pursuant to military orders, if the motor home was registered or licensed by the person in another state while a bona 8 fide resident of that state, and the person produces specific 9 documentation, as determined by the department of revenue, indicating 10 that he or she was not a resident of Washington at any time during the 11 12 six months before bringing the motor home into Washington.

For purposes of this section, "state" means a state of the United States, any political subdivision thereof, the District of Columbia, and any foreign country or political subdivision thereof.
