1 AN ACT Relating to the state building code; and amending RCW
2 19.27.031.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 19.27.031 and 1995 c 343 s 1 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 Except as otherwise provided in this chapter, there shall be in
7 effect in all counties and cities the state building code which shall
8 consist of the following codes which are hereby adopted by reference:

9 (1) ~~((Uniform Building Code and Uniform Building Code Standards))~~
10 NFPA 5000, Building Construction and Safety Code, published by the
11 ~~((International Conference of Building Officials))~~ National Fire
12 Protection Association;

13 (2) ~~((Uniform Mechanical Code, including Chapter 13, Fuel Gas~~
14 ~~Piping, Appendix B, published by the International Conference of~~
15 ~~Building Officials;~~

16 ~~(3) The))~~ NFPA 1, Uniform Fire Code ((and Uniform Fire Code
17 Standards)), published by the ~~((International Fire Code Institute;~~
18 PROVIDED, That,)) National Fire Protection Association. However,

1 notwithstanding any wording in this code, participants in religious
2 ceremonies shall not be precluded from carrying hand-held candles;

3 ~~((4))~~ (3) Except as provided in RCW 19.27.170, the Uniform
4 Plumbing Code and Uniform Plumbing Code Standards, published by the
5 International Association of Plumbing and Mechanical Officials(~~(+--~~
6 ~~PROVIDED, That chapters 11 and 12 of such code)~~). However, any
7 provisions of these codes affecting sewers or fuel gas piping are not
8 adopted;

9 (4) Uniform Mechanical Code, published by the International
10 Association of Plumbing and Mechanical Officials; and

11 (5) The rules and regulations adopted by the council establishing
12 standards for making buildings and facilities accessible to and usable
13 by the physically handicapped or elderly persons as provided in RCW
14 70.92.100 through 70.92.160.

15 In case of conflict among the codes enumerated in subsections (1),
16 (2), (3), and (4) of this section, the first named code shall govern
17 over those following.

18 The codes enumerated in this section shall be adopted by the
19 council as provided in RCW 19.27.074.

20 The council may issue opinions relating to the codes at the request
21 of a local official charged with the duty to enforce the enumerated
22 codes.
