- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 9A.76.200 and 1993 c 180 s 2 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) A person is guilty of harming a police dog ((<del>or</del>)), accelerant
- 8 disables, shoots, or kills by any means any dog or horse that the

detection dog, or police horse, if he or she maliciously injures,

- 9 person knows or has reason to know to be a police dog or accelerant
- 10 detection dog, as defined in RCW 4.24.410, or police horse, as defined
- in subsection (2) of this section, whether or not the dog or horse is
- 12 actually engaged in police or accelerant detection work at the time of
- 13 the injury.

- 14 (2) "Police horse" means any horse used or kept for use by a law
- 15 enforcement officer in discharging any legal duty or power of his or
- 16 her office.
- 17 <u>(3)</u> Harming a police dog ((<del>or</del>)), accelerant detection dog, or
- 18 police horse is a class C felony.
